Scotia-Glenville's school buildings were greatly improved during the 1999 building project. But, in order to bring costs in line with the construction bids at the time, many items were deleted from that project.

Now, a decade later, those needs still remain and others have cropped up.

For the past several months, the Board of Education has been studying several building issues, including:



- Science labs, technology/industrial arts and family/consumer sciences classrooms and an "open" library with no walls at the Middle School that were built in the early 1970s;
- Technology/industrial arts classrooms at the High School virtually unchanged since they were built 50 years ago;
- Elementary roofs that are near the end of their lives; and
- Athletic fields that have taken a beating for years and need upgrades or replacement.
